This project will also include potential licensing for web logic, SOA, and OBIEE in addition to HW.

WEBLOGIC ENVIRONMENT REVIEW & ASSESSMENT

ComTrac is a Southern Company key financial vendor application that manages fuel inventory and accounting. ComTrac currently runs on Weblogic 9.2 and Windows environment. The application has been experiencing overall performance issues and periodic WebLogic errors that frequently require restarts to correct. BIAS has been tasked with performing a review and assessment of the ComTrac WebLogic environment and provide recommendations that will help address performance and stability problems.

- 10gR3/11g installation and configuration WebLogic Technical knowledge sharing and mentoring

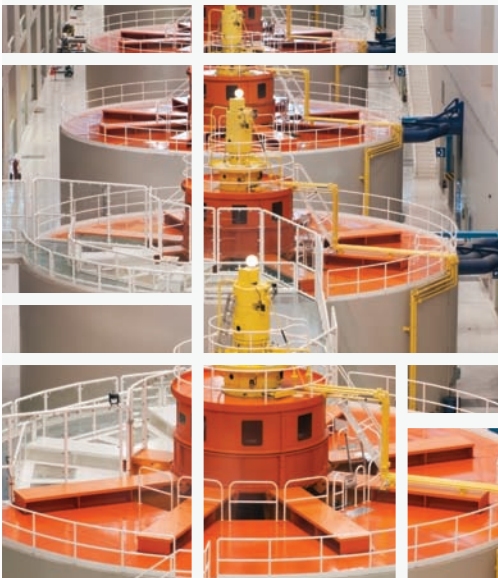
OBIEE SOLUTION
